Detailed description of Figure 1: The graph plots the percentage of total catch against the percentage of total effort for five different fishing scenarios. The x-axis represents 'Percentage of total effort' from 0 to 100. The y-axis represents 'Percentage of total catch' from 0 to 100. The legend identifies the following series:
 

- Yellow perch:** A solid line with open circles. It starts at (0,0) and rises steeply, reaching approximately 80% catch at 20% effort, then levels off.
- Rock bass:** A dashed line with open triangles. It starts at (0,0) and rises more gradually than yellow perch, reaching about 40% catch at 20% effort.
